'Name Your Seat' **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Seat availability

A total of 178 seats are available for naming opportunities in Featherstone Hall, comprising 14 'Platinum' seats, 8 'Gold' seats, 31 'Silver' seats, and 125 'Bronze' seats.

The 'Platinum', 'Gold', 'Silver' and 'Bronze' packages are differentiated by their location in Featherstone Hall and donation amount.

The School reserves the right to alter the allocation of seats and prices as appropriate.

2. Seat 'Name Plaques'

Official commencement of 'Name Your Seat' will occur from Wednesday 12 August 2026 when the community has access to donate to the Building Fund. Donations of a 'Platinum', 'Gold', 'Silver' or 'Bronze' package will be recognised in the form of a name plaque on a seat in Featherstone Hall. Seat name plaques will be strictly on a first-come-first served allocation and the school reserves the right to pause and/or close the naming of seats at anytime.

A name plaque on a seat does not entitle the donor to a reserved seat at events in Featherstone Hall.

3. Payment terms

Donors of a 'Platinum', 'Silver', 'Gold' or 'Bronze' package are required to make their donation in full for all seats and the accompanying dedication plaque at the time of payment.

All prices are inclusive of GST



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4. Appearance of Name Plaques

The name plaque is Satin Stainless Steel with either a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Finish, depending on the seat purchased, measuring 100mm x 60mm.

5. Plaque wording

The dedication plaque engraved wording allows for individuals, staff, families, and friends of Strathcona Girls Grammar community to be recognised. The first line will require sponsors to choose one of the following three options: “Dedicated to”, “In honour of” or “Supported by”.

The next two lines provide a maximum of 20 characters per line including spaces where donors can dedicate a message or family names to be engraved on the plaque.

All wording must be in English.

6. Plaque placement

The dedication plaques will be affixed to the back of the fixed seats.

7. Right of removal

The School reserves the right to remove a seat plaque at any stage in the future if the actions of the individual or family named may bring the School into public disrepute. Any removal would be subject to review and approval by the Strathcona Girls Grammar Principal, and no refunds will be offered.

8. Availability of unnamed seats

All unnamed seats will remain available for recognition of future donations until all seats are sold.

9. Duration

Dedication name plaques on the fixed seats will remain in place for the life of the building and/or seats whichever is shorter, in accordance with the School’s Naming Recognition Policy.



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10. **Damage or replacement**

If any plaques and/or seats are damaged, a replacement plaque and/or seat will be arranged, with the same terms and conditions applying.

11. **Tax status**

In accordance with the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) regulations, a tax-deductible receipt will be issued as a donation to Strathcona Girls Grammar's Building and Maintenance Fund.

12. **Privacy**

All information collected for the purpose of this Featherstone Hall 'name your seat' campaign will be used and stored in accordance with the School's Privacy Policy. Full details of the Privacy Policy are available on the school website.
